Free seminar for members of the police forces and lawyers on web-intelligence and social media analysis, the use of UAVs (drones) for investigations, facial expression analysis during investigative interviews.

Nowadays, police forces are forced to deal with an increasingly complex reality and with ever-changing social dynamics. As a consequence, investigations need innovative analytic tools appropriate for the different aspects of police activity.

Similarly, lawyers that carry out defensive investigations can benefit from techniques that allow a more efficient collection of information to assist their client.

The goal of this free seminar is to provide an overview of the most innovative and modern techniques that can be used by both police forces and lawyers:

- web-intelligence, which together with social media analysis facilitates the collection of information from the internet even automatically thanks to special software accelerating criminal identification or allowing crime prevention. In the case of defensive investigations, these techniques can support lawyers in collecting data useful to clear their client of all charges.
- Facial expression analysis, which is of great importance during investigative interviews and can highlight some aspects of the deposition, allowing the interviewer (police or lawyer) to understand whether or not the person interviewed is telling the truth.
- The use of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs) or drones in police and forensic investigations, a technique that can be particularly useful in the case of environmental crimes.

During the seminar, practical examples of the different techniques will be provided.
